Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What clothing should cadets wear before they get their uniform?

On starting with the Squadron, cadets will be expected to wear a shirt, tie and smart trousers/skirt with polished shoes. School uniform is acceptable.

When are cadets issued with uniform?

Uniform is issued after a probationary period once the cadet has completed initial training.

What will cadets do for the first few weeks?

Cadets will join a recruit flight where they will receive basic training in drill, uniform preparation and military knowledge. Once they have completed their basic training they will receive a certificate and a Record of Service book.

Several times throughout the year, enrolment ceremonies are held where recruits attest the cadet promise. Family members are usually invited to attend. We will send a formal invitation to you if an event is due to take place.

What kit do cadets need to buy?

Recruits will be issued with a uniform but some items need to be provided by the cadet.

Cadets often accrue a large amount of equipment as they engage in more activities and we do not expect cadets to purchase absolutely everything they might need right from the start.

However they <u>must</u> purchase the following ASAP:

- Parade Shoes
- Assault Boots (Black)
- Working Dress Belt (Olive Green)

How do cadets get involved in activities/events?

Cadets will get the opportunity to take part in various camps, training, sports and visits.

In order to attend these activities the cadet needs to:

- 1. Sign-up for the activities advertised on the notice-board
- 2 Submit consent forms & money before the deadline


Do cadets have to attend both Tuesday and Thursday nights?
